How to Submit a Faculty Proposal for the CANSSI Distinguished Postdoctoral Fellowships (CDPF) Program

Audience: faculty members in statistical sciences at Canadian universities

Each year, CANSSI invites faculty members in statistical sciences at Canadian universities to submit project proposals outlining a comprehensive research and training experience for CANSSI-supported postdoctoral fellows. The projects are offered to applicants for CANSSI Distinguished Postdoctoral Fellowships and, if appropriate, related programs like the CANSSI Ontario Postdoctoral Fellowship in Statistics and the CANSSI-StatLab Distinguished Postdoctoral Fellowship.

This document explains how to complete the online submission process.

Title of the proposed research project	The title should clearly express the nature of the research that will be undertaken.

Research project abstract	<p>Provide a project description suitable for use in posting the fellowship position. The description should summarize the purpose and aims of the research, potential applications and/or theoretical impact, and the anticipated role and activities of the postdoctoral fellow.</p> <p>Upload your abstract as a Word or PDF document (up to 1/4 page/750 characters).</p>

Research description	<p>The proposed research should be suitable for a postdoctoral fellow in scope and sophistication. Describe the proposed research project, including research goals, possible approaches, potential applied and/or theoretical impact, the resources needed to complete the research, and where the research will be carried out. Indicate the roles of the Supervisor, the Co-supervisor, and the postdoctoral fellow and how the three will work together.</p> <p>If a Supervisor or Co-supervisor holds an NSERC Discovery Grant in the same research area, indicate how the postdoctoral project relates to the Discovery Grant.</p> <p>Upload the description as a Word or PDF document (up to 2 pages/6,000 characters, including references). Note: this section will NOT be used in the posting for the fellowship position.</p>
Plan for interdisciplinary/applied experience	<p>The project must include an immersive interdisciplinary or applied project. This should include a significant interaction with a researcher, organization, or group directly related to experiments, data, and application. Alternately, a methodologic interdisciplinary collaboration could replace this activity. Describe the experience, including its importance in training and its connection to applications and data. State where this experience will occur and the roles of those involved. Describe the suitability of the proposed interdisciplinary partners for mentoring the experience.</p>

	<p>Upload your plan as a Word or PDF document (up to 1/3 page/1,000 characters). Note: this section will be used in the posting for the fellowship position.</p>
<p>Plan for teaching/training/education</p>	<p>Educational and communication activities should provide the postdoctoral fellow with the opportunity to gain important teaching and mentoring skills. The amount of activity should be the equivalent of teaching at least one but not more than two courses over two years. The standard expectation is teaching a three-credit, one-semester course. Please contact Andrea Benedetti at andrea.benedetti@mcgill.ca if you need assistance in meeting this requirement.</p> <p>List the plans for each of the two years.</p> <p>Upload your plan as a Word or PDF document (up to 1/4 page/750 characters). Note: this section will be used in the posting for the fellowship position.</p>
<p>Plan for mentoring</p>	<p>Describe the plan for mentoring the postdoctoral fellow to learn and excel in the project activities. Also, describe the plan for additional career preparation, EDI training, and other opportunities.</p> <p>Describe the role of each mentor. If the project includes a Mentor in addition to the Supervisor and Co-supervisor, include a plan for how the Mentor will be integrated into the project.</p> <p>Describe the opportunities, activities, and support that the host institutions offer for postdoctoral fellows.</p>

	<p>Upload your plan as a Word or PDF document (up to 1/2 page/1,500 characters). Note: this section will be used in the posting for the fellowship position.</p>
Proposed schedule	<p>Detail the timing of research, teaching, and the interdisciplinary/applied experiences along with a schedule of time at the institutions involved with the plan. Include schedules for year 1 and year 2.</p> <p>Upload the schedule as a Word or PDF document (up to 1/3 page/1,000 characters). Note: this section will be used in the posting for the fellowship position.</p>
List of qualifications of suitable candidates	<p>The list should be appropriate for an advertisement for the postdoctoral position.</p> <p>Upload the list as a Word or PDF document (up to 1/4 page/750 characters). Note: this section will be used in the posting for the fellowship position.</p>
Budget	<p>Use the CDPF Budget Template to detail all sources of funding for the postdoctoral fellowship.</p> <p>Upload the completed budget document as a Word or PDF document.</p>
Biographical sketches	<p>Use the CANSSI Faculty Bio Template to provide biographical sketches of the Supervisor and Co-supervisor.</p> <p>Upload the bios as Word or PDF documents.</p>

Co-supervisor's qualifications	<p>If the Co-supervisor is not a faculty member at a university, include a paragraph justifying the proposed arrangement and establishing the Co-supervisor's capacity to supervise the research of the postdoctoral fellow.</p> <p>Upload your explanation as a Word or PDF document (up to 1/4 page/750 characters).</p>
Institutional commitment	<p>Please provide a brief communication from the relevant department chair indicating knowledge of the teaching plan and commitment to the assignment.</p> <p>Upload the statement as a Word or PDF document.</p>
